## Charlotte Enblom

Most of them helping others.

Charlotte Enblom's life was all about family, flowers and friends. She was a lifelong learner a voracious reader. From an early age, she cultivated friendships that lasted her entire life. Her greatest achievement was raising her family along with her husband.
