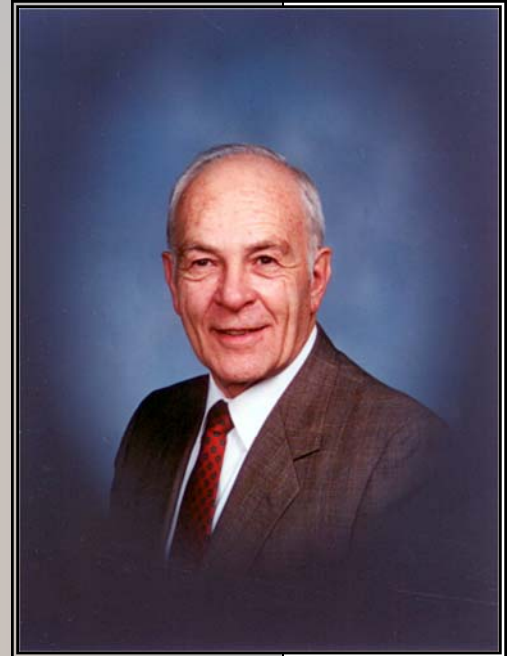


James E. Sjoldal
