## Anne Caroline Larson (Dieffenbach)

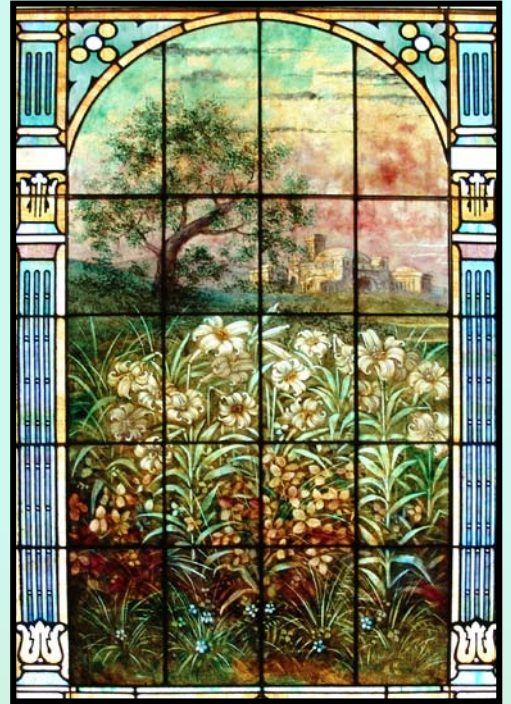
