Age 103 was born April 29, 1904 in Hollywood Township, Carver County, Minnesota. Mildred went to be at rest with her friend and savior, Jesuson Thursday, December 27, 2007. Her mother, Mary (Nelson) Ekgren and her father Peter Ekgren homesteaded a farm west of Watertown, Minnesota in the late 1880's. Mildred attended a one-room school in Oster, Minnesota and graduated from Minnehaha Academy in 1922. Mildred graduated from the Swedish Hospital Nursing School in May of 1926. She also attended the University of Minnesota and UCLA. Following graduation she did private nursing and took an internship in Philadelphia, PA. She returned to Minnesota where she worked for 9 years as an Assistant director of Nursing at the Bethesda Hospital in St. Paul. She took training in tuberculosis care in Mississippi and then she worked in Au-ga-chin TB Sanitarium in Walker, Minnesota.

Mildred served as director of Nursing, Carbondale, Illinois, the Los Angeles County Hospital for one year. In 1965 she became the Director of Nursing and later the Director of Volunteers at the Methodist Hospital in Arcadia, California. She also served as Medical Director at the Methodist Retirement complex in Claremont, California. Mildred was a member of the Prairie Hill Evangelical Free Church in Eden Prairie, Minnesota.

Mildred married David Nelson in June of 1944. They lived in Pomona and Glendale, California. After retirement they moved to Mesa, Arizona and later to Glendale Arizona. Mildred has lived in the Elim Shored Retirement Residence in Eden Prairie and during the last nine years she lived in Redeemer Health and Rehab Residence in Minneapolis. The family wishes to express their special thanks to the Redeemer staff for their loving care.
