John Walker "T" Adams III was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota on May 16, 1921 to his parents John Walker Adams, Jr. and Doris (Leslie) Adams. He passed away on Saturday, March 5, 2011 at the age of 89 years, 9 months and 19 days. "T" graduated from University of Minnesota with a B.S. in Civil Engineering in 1942 and received a J.D. at the University of Minnesota Law School in 1946. He dedicated his career to Patent Law. A longtime Deephaven resident, he was a Member and Chairman of both Richfield and Minnetonka School Boards and served on the Minneapolis Big Brother Board and the Minneapolis Athletic Club Board. He was an avid athlete, lettering in both hockey and tennis three

consecutive years at the University of Minnesota, achieving the Conference Medal for Scholastic and Athletic Prowess in 1946. He coached hockey in Hopkins for nine years, played hockey until age 55 and tennis until 82. After attending Northern Pines Christian Family Camp in 1977, he had a "life changing" experience. In the years that followed, he was active in Bible Study Fellowship (BSF) as a group leader; Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) and Christian Conciliation Services.
