



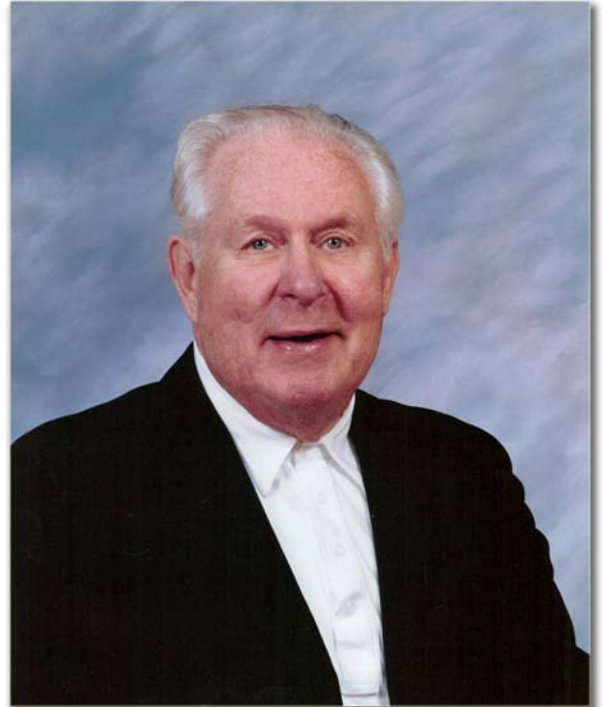
IN LOVING MEMORY OF
